

## UPPER DELAWARE SOIL CONSERVATION DISTRICT REQUIREMENTS FOR PERFORMANCE DEPOSITS

1. Deposit must be **cash**, or **bank certified check** made payable to “Upper Delaware Soil Conservation District.”
2. Amount of Deposit will be calculated at \$2500 per disturbed acre, or part thereof. If project is multi-family residential, it is based on \$2500 per building. (Buildings requiring more than one C.O. must be done as a whole building even if only one C.O. is currently needed.)
3. Performance Deposit must be paid prior to scheduling inspection for Temporary Certificate of Compliance. Please allow about one week scheduling time.
4. Deposits must be posted at the District office in Blirstown.
5. Disturbed areas must be temporarily stabilized in order for the District to issue the Temporary Certificate of Compliance. Mulch tacking agents will be required.
6. No **permanent** Certificates of Compliance for lots without a deposit will be released in those projects that have posted performance deposits, until the performance deposits have been released.
7. The normal deposit period is for the non-growing season. The periods may be extended depending on growing conditions. To avoid a deposit during the non-growing season, the soil can be stabilized permanently by putting down sod.
